SUBJECT: FY22 Proposed Fee Increases

After a review of all programs offered by the Natick Public Schools, presented for your approval, are the following fee increases for two of our programs.

(Beginning in FY19, the school committee recommended an annual review of all fees with in order to avoid a large fee increase in any given fiscal year. The recommendation was an annual 2% increase for those programs where a fee increase is justified. No fee increases were increased in FY21 due to the pandemic.)

The following are proposed fee increases for FY22:
