Per federal guidelines, adult meal prices are calculated using a formula based on reimbursement and meal value to generate a minimum price. FY19 minimum adult meal pricing is required to be \$2.03 for breakfast and \$3.55 for lunch. Our current adult meal prices are \$1.25 for breakfast and \$3.50 for lunch.

In order to be in compliance with federal and state guidelines, I am writing to request the adult meal pricing for Natick Public Schools be changed to \$2.25 for breakfast and \$4.00 for lunch.
