SUBJECT: Financial Report – As of December 31, 2018

Attached please find the 2nd Quarter Financial Report (December 31, 2018) for the Natick Public Schools.

The report is divided into two sections. The first section provides a summary review of each department. Columns include the following:

SECTION 1

- Budget These amounts represent the FY19 Approved Budget
- YTD Expended These amounts represent money spend year to date (July 1 Dec 31).
- Encumbrances/Requisitions These amounts include funds that are anticipated to be expended during the remainder of the fiscal year and administrators have completed a purchase requisition encumbering (reserving) these amounts pending the receipt of actual invoices.
- Subtotal The subtotal of amounts from adding the YTD Expenses and Encumbrances.
- Balance The remaining amount of funds available.
- Wused The percentage of funds expended or encumbered for this period of time. Compare this percentage with the time lapsed for the report period (for example Jul-Dec represents 50% of the year).

SECTION 2

- Provides an overview of salaries versus all other expenses.
- Since salaries represent 78% of our total expenses this analysis provides a snapshot of our overall spending as it relates to salaries.

SECOND QUARTER ANALYSIS

<u>Districtwide Expenses</u> (66.12% expended) - Encumbrances of \$3,303,689 account for approximately 20% these expenses. At the beginning of the fiscal year, the Business Office allows for encumbrances for several items such as Out of District tuitions, utilities, internet, professional development, etc. in order to reserve these funds for the remainder of the fiscal year.

<u>Salaries</u> (37.45%) – The second quarter of the fiscal year (Jul-Dec) accounts for fourteen payrolls for year round employees and nine payrolls for school year employees. Both groups receive 26 payrolls with school year employees (teachers) receiving a lump sum final payment at the end of June. The percentage expensed year to date will begin to align closer to the budget amount as additional payrolls are expensed.
