



- 3. New family registration (April)



#### Wait List

19-20: 60% of new registrants (123 children) were enrolled for some or all days

Last year, 20% of children came off the wait list between May and August



Annually, an average of 130 wait listed children are offered one or more requested days before school starts

#### **Elementary Enrichment**
