Public Speak

Chair McDonough began with Public Speak. She asked if anyone was here for Public Speak. No one came forward.

Review and Discussion of 2019/2020 District Goals

Dr. Nolin led the meeting in an initial discussion of Distraict and Superintendent Goals for the 2019/2020 School Year. The School Committee began with a five-minute personality test that was designed to help us understand one another's personalities and working styles.

A brief discussion of norms followed and Dr. Nolin suggested the committee review its own norms. Dr. Nolin invited the School Committee to opening day with the faculty on Monday, August 26th at noon. Dr. Nolin presented a comprehensive and data rich power point presentation and suggested the committee spend time studying and analyzing it prior to the next meeting. She shared her analysis of the U.S. News and World Report data explaining that Natick was now considered to be in a wealthier cohort of schools, which means in comparison it lacks the supports and resources of its peers that drive student achievement. Discussion also ensued on AP courses and Dr. Nolin explained that now what is important is the number of students passing AP exams not just the number taking them as in the past.

At approximately 9:30pm, Ms. Collins moved to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Brand seconded. It was unanimously approved by those present 7-0-0.
