#### **Public Speak**

Chair McDonough asked if anyone wished to come forward for Public Speak. No one came forward.

### **Budget and Complexity Presentation**

Dr. Nolin along with Erin Miller, Director of Student Services, Jordan Hoffman, Principal – Johnson School, MaryBeth Kinkead, Principal – Natick Preschool, Karen Dalton-Thomas, Department Head for Guidance and Brian Harrigan, Principal -Natick High School gave a presentation, found in Novus Agenda, that gave the Committee as well as the community the budget backdrop and budget drivers. The presentation surrounded how Natick Public Schools has changed in the last five years relative to building management and day-today life in the classroom. Dr. Nolin explained the difference in classrooms today and the different learning environments. She reviewed all the medical needs of students, special needs of students, needs of English language learners and the need for added psychological and learning support. Dr. Nolin infused her belief that all students should have a chance at a successful, productive adult life of their choosing and that all learners are capable of success in the Natick Public Schools. The School Committee asked several thoughtful questions to which the panel answered in detail.

# **First Draft Budget Presentation**

Dr. Peter Gray gave a presentation and he informed the School Committee that this was 36<sup>th</sup> fiscal year of budget presentations to various governmental agencies. Dr. Gray explained how the budget process has accelerated over the past couple of years and now begins in July. Typically, budgets were not started until after the holidays so the district could have clearer information as to expenses. Dr. Gray gave detailed

information on how the budget numbers were reached. The School Committee asked several questions regarding addressing complexity and personnel to manage those complexities and Dr. Gray as well as Dr. Nolin, answered them in great detail.

At approximately, 9:44pm, Mr. Michael Hickey, Chair of the Board of Selectmen entered the room and announced an evacuation of the building due to a strong gas odor on the second floor. Ms. Sonneborn moved to adjourn. Mr. Brand seconded. It was unanimously approved by a vote of the four members present, 4-0-0.
