Discussion of Johnson and Memorial School - Space and Capital Planning

This meeting was more specifically a community forum for Johnson School families. The format of tonight's meeting was reviewed. Chair McDonough thanked everyone who submitted questions and comments as well as providing feedback. Dr. Nolin gave a presentation that reviewed history of the building and space planning in the district from as far back as 1980. Dr. Nolin reviewed the vision of Natick Public Schools, the current problems before them, important calendar considerations, and school building conversions/consolidations. She went on to review the school building renovations and replacements. Dr. Nolin discussed the Dore & Whittier Master Study from May 2012 which studied the space at Kennedy, Johnson and Memorial, the TBA Architects study from December 2020 which studied space at all schools, the minutes and notes from the Space Advisory Committee from May 2021which through School Council representatives, feedback was solicited from middle and elementary school communities in Natick, the Interim Town Administrator Working Group Report from August 2021which the Committee had studied possible infrastructure and operational efficiencies that could be realized to maximize town resources. Dr. Nolin reviewed the financial pressures for the schools and Town. She continued by reviewed enrollment data from past to present. Dr. Nolin reviewed what the closing of the Johnson School would look like to staff, students and families. The remaining time of the meeting was spent listening to comments and concerns from the Johnson School parent community as well as a few other community members.
